Intake- Ongoing

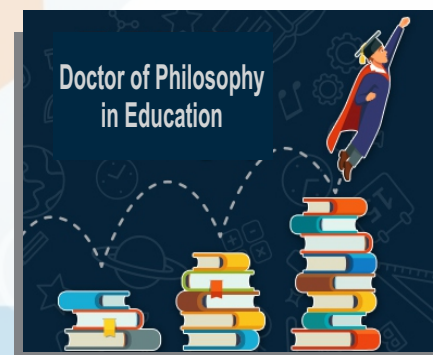
Entry Requirements:
